Blaine Rieke has been a Director of the Huge Foundation since 2010. Mr. Rieke graduated from Nebraska Wesleyan University in 1955, received his law degree from the University of Nebraska in 1960 and his MBA from the Booth Chicago Business School in 1970.

Since 2003 until the present date he has served on the Board of Directors of Members Trust Company, Tampa, Florida.
