Mr. Huge has been a director of the Huge Foundation since 2005.

For the past 25 years, Mr. Huge has served as a consultant to schools, educational institutions, large corporations, small businesses, and professional and trade associations, both nationally and internationally, in the areas of organizational analysis and design, executive selection and coaching, student achievement, conflict management, communication, interpersonal relations, and organizational development.

He has performed executive coaching for large corporations such as Disney and The GAP, as well as for public sector leaders, including Superintendents, Chief Executive Officers, Chief Academic Officers, Chief Operating Officers, principals, and U.S. Congressional Representatives.
